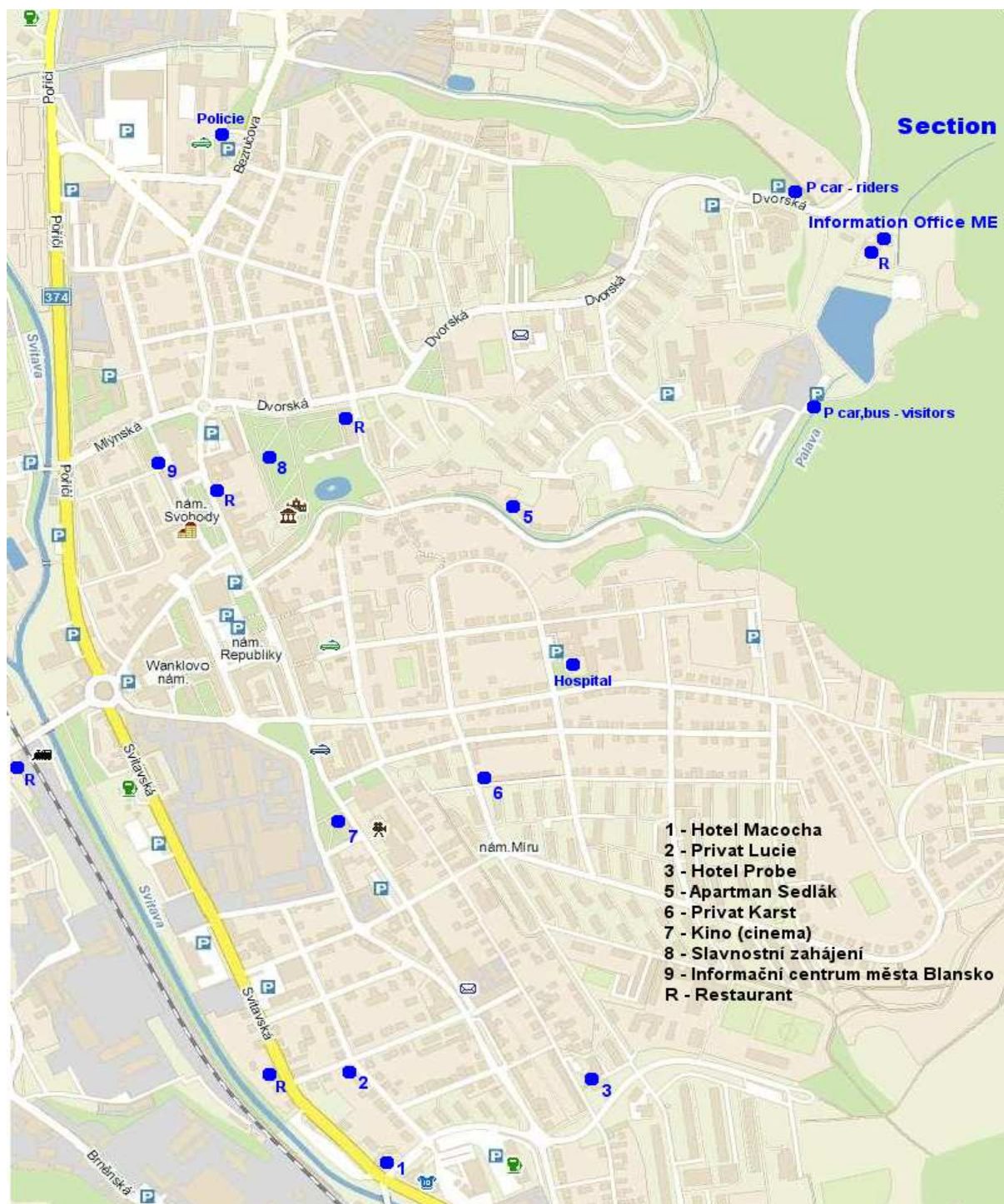

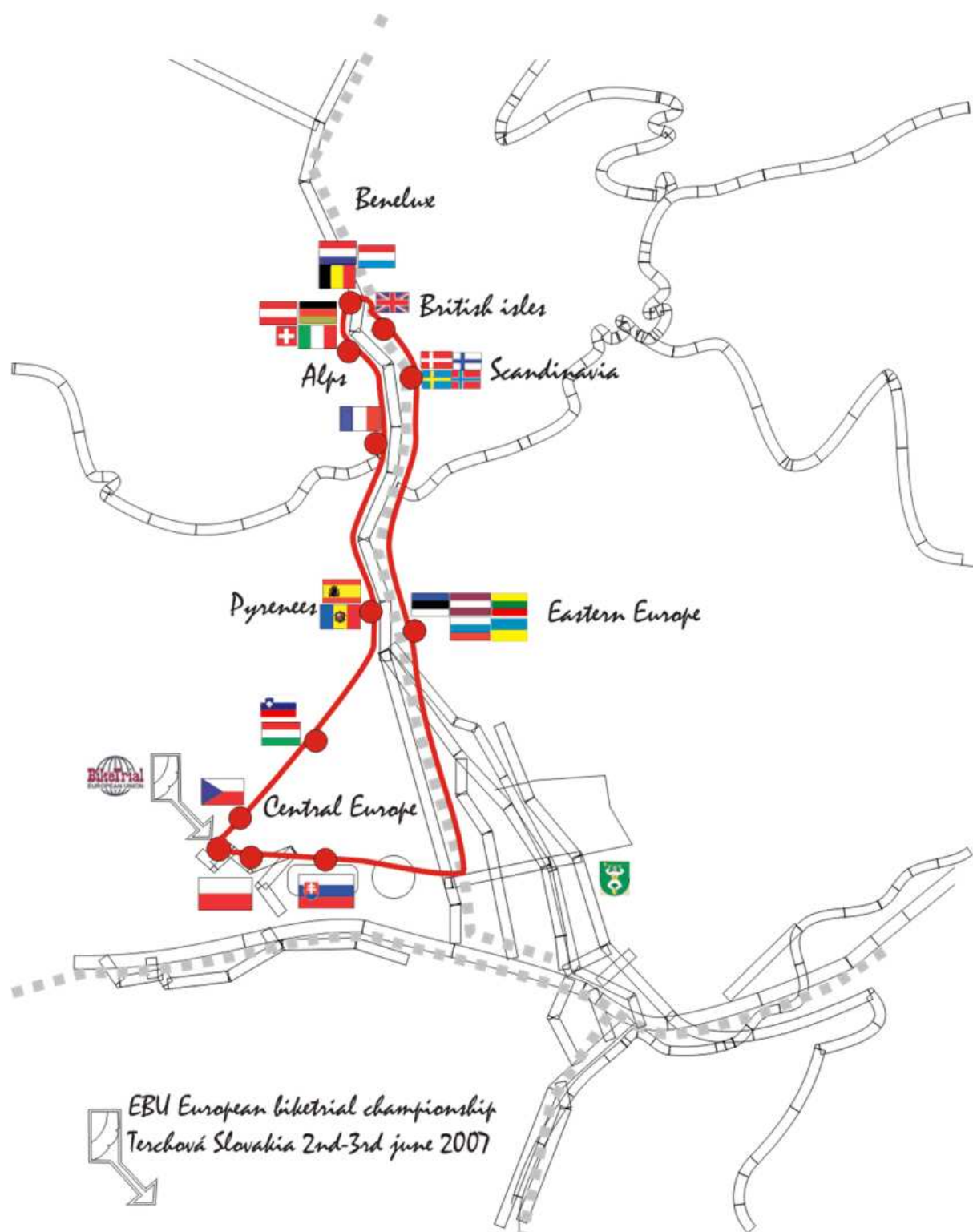
Map of accommodation at EBC 2006, Blansko, Czech Republic:

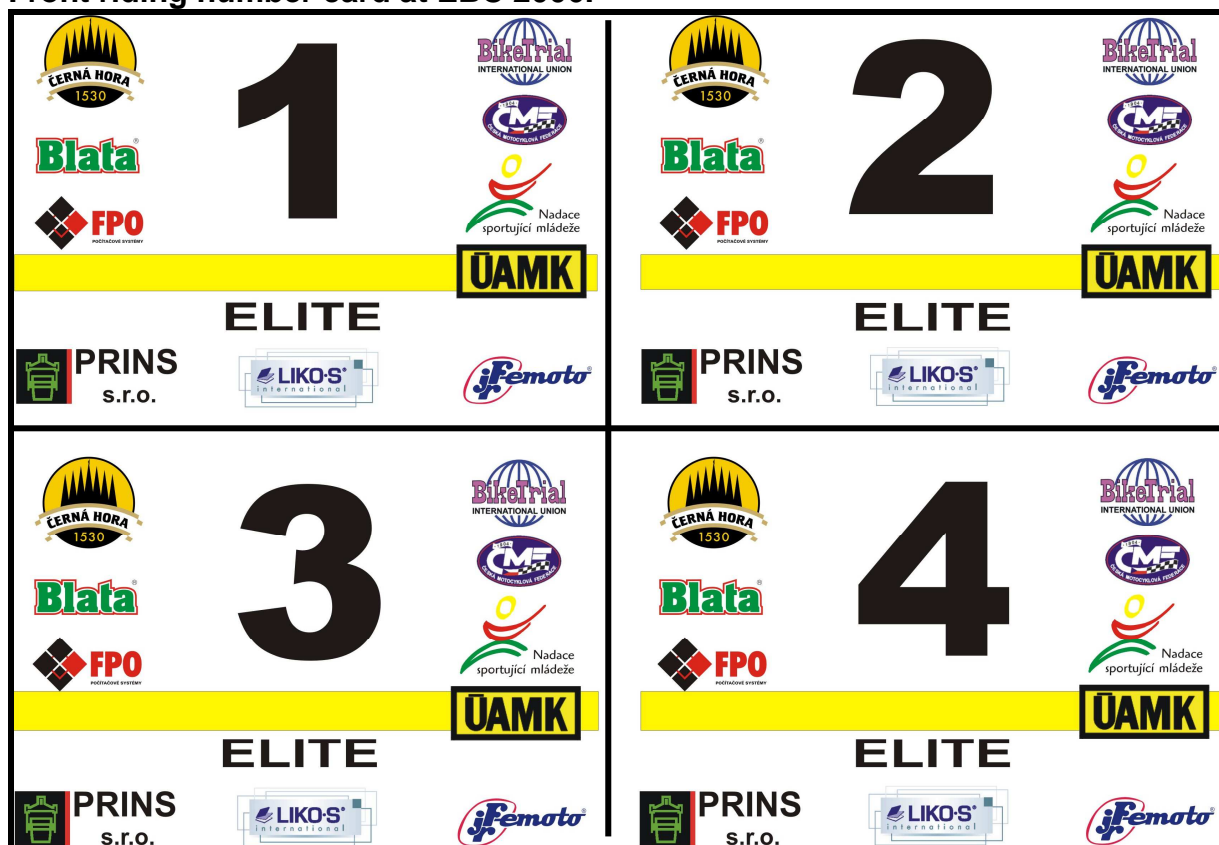

13. OBSERVERS MEETING

Observers meeting will be held in the morning on Saturday and Sunday. The chief of the observers will tell of special notices to the observers. The International observer must have the card of the International observer. All observers must take the following pledge:

Promise of observers

„On behalf of all the observers who will be taking part in the (year) European BikeTrial Championships in (town & country where the competition is held), I promise that we will act in a completely neutral and impartial manner when judging competitors from all nations. We will carry out our duties to the best of our abilities in order to provide a fair and correct result“

Guidelines for International Observers for the European BikeTrial Championship

Art.01 REPRESENTED COUNTRIES

1.1 The European BikeTrial Championship will aim to have a representation of qualified, International Observers participating at the competition. All other Observers should be provided by the host country.

1.2 Each E.B.U. delegate who has riders competing in the European BikeTrial Championship will be invited to provide at least one International Observer for both days of the competition. Every International Observer must have an International Observers Licence issued by the E.B.U.

1.3 The organiser of the European Biketrial Championship will arrange a meeting for all Observers before the start of both the Saturday and Sunday competitions. This meeting will be to give the 'Observers' Promise' and the necessary instructions to each of the Observers.

1.4 The organiser will supply clear identification (e.g. a colour coded T-shirt or arm band) to each of the observers so that the riders and spectators can easily identify them. The International Observer will be in overall control of their section will also wear their International Observers Licence. The organiser will supply the time keeper and punch card scorer.

1.5 The event organiser will supply all of the clocks, punches and yellow and red warning cards to be used by the Observers on each section.

1.6 The organiser will be allowed to choose what conditions and benefits he wishes to give to the Observers .

Art.02 QUALIFIED OBSERVERS AND LICENCES

2.1 It is recommended that an Observer should have at least two (2) years experience of observing at national level in their own countries and should be familiar with the Biketrial International Union (B.I.U) rules as explained in the International Technical Rules (I.T.R). The national delegate of each country will confirm that their International Observers meet the required standards and will sign their application forms accordingly.

2.2 A qualified observer must be over 18 years of age.

2.3 Each qualified observer must be able to give instructions in English whilst they are observing in the competition (e.g. giving the time, penalty points, orders and instructions to the rider).



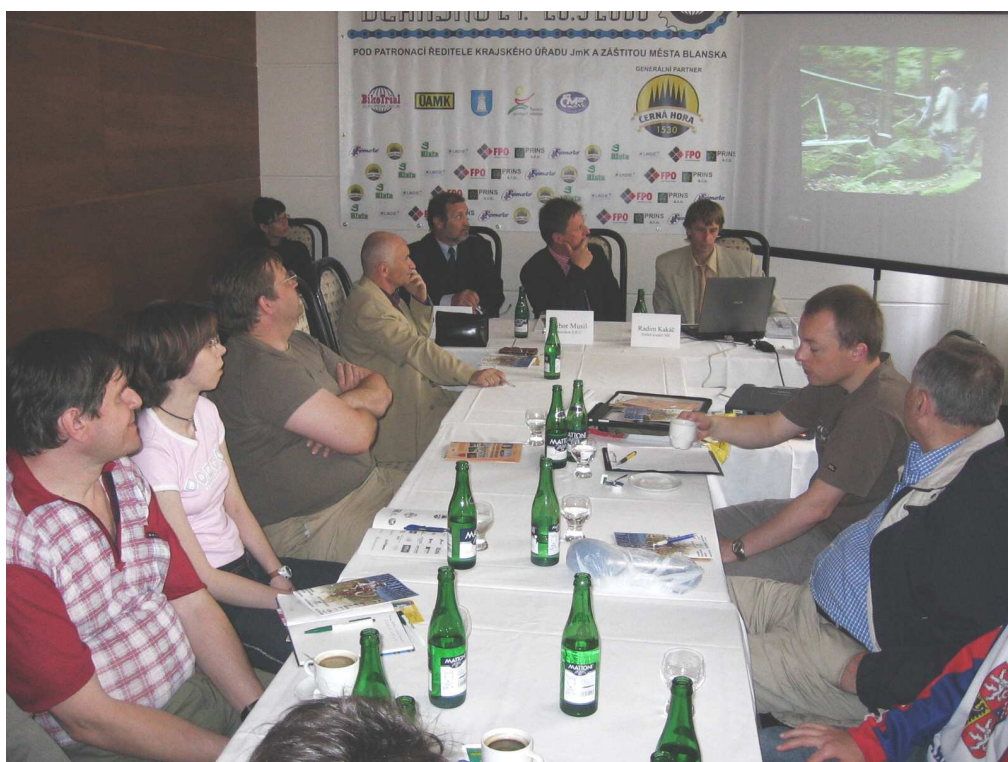

24. GUIDELINES FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE EUROPEAN BIKETRIAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Art.01 CHAMPIONSHIP

1.1 The Championship will only comprise of one competition. These Championships will be held according to the rules and regulations of the Biketrial International Union (B.I.U) and will be subject to the International Technical Rules (I.T.R.).

Art.02 ENTRY FEE

2.1 Each competitor will pay a ten (10) Euro entry fee to the organiser to take part in the competition. This money will be for the use of the organiser to assist in the funding of the event.

Art.03 PROMOTION

3.1 A programme and information about the event must be sent to all delegates at least three (3) months before the event and these will include the following items:

The authorities and organizers

The delegates of the E.B.U. and the president of the host nation.

Local supporting bodies.

Sponsors

Time schedule

Official acts towards the event

Details of the location of the start and finish areas, competition head office, registration area, medical centre, bank and local shops.

A local plan showing information about accommodation and also reminding delegates that accommodation for competitors is not free (see Art. 03.3).

3.2 The organiser must send general information about the event to the E.B.U. head office at least five (5) months before the event so that it can be promoted by the E.B.U.

3.3 The organisers will not have to provide free accommodation for the competitors. They will be expected however to provide information about local accommodation (hotels and camping etc....) and ensure that there is sufficient capacity for the number of competitors.

3.4 A poster advertising the event must be printed giving the following information:

Biketrial printed in its original lettering
The European Biketrial Championship
Dates of the event
Official logo of European Biketrial Union
Official logo of the National Union
Official organisations
Sponsors
Supporting bodies

Art.04 PRESENTATION OF TEAMS

4.1 The organiser will arrange a ceremony for the presentation of the international teams with their respective national anthems to take place on the Saturday evening.

The organiser shall state in the programme for the delegates that all riders registered in the competition and heads of the national teams or their representatives are obliged to take part in this ceremony.
The organiser should accompany the official ceremony with a short cultural programme.

4.2 The national delegates must send a list of riders from each category two (2) months before the event and they have to confirm this list one (1) month before the event.

Art.05 COMPETITIONS

5.1 The organiser will arrange for the inspection of each competitor's bicycle and an inspection of each competitor's clothing prior to the competition starting.

5.2 The Saturday competition will be for the following categories: - Poussin, Benjamin, Minime and Femina. Registration of these riders will take place between 8.30am and 10.00am on Saturday. The start of the first rider will be at 11.00am. The presentation of the trophies for these categories will take place on the Sunday following the end of the competition accompanied by the national anthems and flags of the winning competitors.

5.3 The Sunday competition will be for the following categories: -Cadet, Senior, Elite, Expert and Masters. Registration of these riders will be on Saturday afternoon. The presentation of the trophies will take place on the same day as the competition along with the national anthems and flags of the winning competitors.

5.4 The 'Nations Cup' will be decided by taking the best rider in each category. Only riders taking part in the ceremony on Saturday evening will be eligible to count towards the 'Nations Cup'. There will not be a Constructors Cup.

5.5 The make of bicycle ridden by each competitor will be shown in the results.

5.6 Identification of riders (to be resolved).

5.7 Non-European riders will be allowed to enter the event but on a non-championship basis and will not be classified in the final results of the European Championship. Riders from outside Europe may be rewarded by the organiser for good performances in the competition.

Art.06 OBSERVERS

6.1 The qualified observers for the event will be multi-national. The E.B.U. will set out the rules for the number of international observers during the European Championship competition and will supply the organiser with the official list of international observers. The organiser will choose observers from the official list of international observers. The organiser will determine the financial conditions for participation of an official international observer. The organiser must have written confirmation of participation in the competition from each international observer. The organiser will include in the time schedules the official meeting before the competition of all the observers along with the chief observer co-ordinator from the E.B.U. (see attachment Observer for the European Biketrial Championship).

6.2 The organiser is expected to provide at least two assistants to every qualified observer for every section in the competition (e.g. time keeper and punch card scorer).

Art.07 JURY

7.1 The members of the JURY are: The President of the E.B.U. as head of the Jury, the delegate of the host country, and the three delegates who have the highest number of riders competing in the event. It will not be permitted that a country has more than one member of the JURY. The E.B.U. President will send a letter to the JURY members three weeks prior to the competition, confirming their position on the JURY.

7.2 The programme for the JURY will be: - checking all the sections (Friday evening), checking the start list and start times - (Saturday morning and afternoon), results checking – (Saturday evening), results checking – (Sunday evening).

7.3 On Saturday evening there will be a meeting of the European delegates.

Art.08 FIRST AID

8.1 Medical service and two ambulances must be provided throughout the entire event.

Art.09 FURTHER RECOMENDATIONS

9.1 The organiser will provide adequate toilet facilities at the venue of the competition.

9.2 The organiser will arrange for suitable refreshments to be on sale to the competitors and spectators at the venue of the competition.

9.3 The organiser will invite (all) manufactures of trials bicycles to have a shop/display present at the venue of the competition. (It is optional whether the right to have a display should be paid for).

9.4 The organiser will provide a large size scoreboard so that results can be clearly seen by everyone.

9.5 The organiser will organise media involvement for the competition and after the competition will publish the results in his own country.

The E.B.U. is the only body which has the right to own and organize the European Biketrial Championships. These Championships will be held according to the rules and regulations of the Biketrial International Union (B.I.U.) and will be subject to the International Technical Rules (I.T.R.).

The organizer of the event, the delegate of the host country and the E.B.U. president must sign this agreement five (5) months before the event.

Art.01 ORGANIZING FEE

The organiser will pay a fee of one thousand (1000) Euros to the E.B.U. This fee must be received by the E.B.U. head office in the Czech Republic by the end of January 2006. After the E.B.U. appoints the organizer for the event, the event is not confirmed until the fee is received. If the fee is not received before the time limit, the E.B.U. will notify all delegates about the cancellation of the event. The fee is non refundable and non-transferable. (ref. to Art.25 I.T.R.) The fee is necessary to cover the expenses of handling the event (planning, promotion, trophies, etc...).

Art.02 CONTROLLER

The E.B.U. President (or a person selected by the President) will act as the controller to check that all the regulations have been adhered to (I.T.R. and any additions). The E.B.U. President will be the decider of a sanction and can ban a country from organizing any future European Biketrial Championships, if the event does not meet E.B.U. standards.

The sanction will consist of at least a two year restriction on holding European Biketrial Championships. If the organizer has not paid the entry fee owed to E.B.U., the restriction will apply until the fee is paid.

Art.03 OTHER ARRANGEMENTS

Further more detailed rules for the organisation of the European Championship are in the Guidelines for the organisation of the European Biketrial Championship, which are an attachment to this agreement.

Should the laws within the country that is organising the European Championship be contrary to any stipulations in this agreement or its attachment, the organiser is obliged to solve this situation after written agreement with the E.B.U. president or his authorised representative.

Any responsibility for the arrangement of the European Championship and dealings with local bodies is borne by the organiser of this event.

In case of any legal disputes arising from this agreement, their resolution shall be carried out by a court in the country where the E.B.U. is registered.

The agreement exists in three complete originals and is valid and effective from the day of signature by both parties to the agreement.

26. CHECK LIST

In organizing of the EBC the organizer should follow the check list. This check list was created for organizing of the WBC but is useable also for the EBC.

The world championship will be arranged and organized according to specific rules which every Biketrial national union will be responsible to carry out precisely.

8	<u>Group-F, the constructor which participates in this category must pay an entry fee, 500 Euro for 20" and 500 Euro for 26" for the whole Championship. The fee must be paid to the BIU through the National Biketrial Union. (the 80% will goes to the National Union and the 20% will goes to the BIU from the fee). The entry will be closed one month before the first event of the Championships. The fee must be paid to the B.I.U. before the first event of the Championships. The name of the brand will be inserted in the official results and the other official documents of the BIU.</u>

I. The organizer of EBC 2007 has decided that the price money for the best riders in Categories ELITE and MASTER at EBC 2007 will be following:

II. Reward for International Observers at EBC 2007

III. International Observers for the European BikeTrial Championship – extract from EBU Observer Guidelines

Art.01 REPRESENTED COUNTRIES

1.1 The European BikeTrial Championship will aim to have a representation of qualified, International Observers participating at the competition. All other Observers should be provided by the host country.

1.2 Each E.B.U. delegate who has riders competing in the European BikeTrial Championship will be invited to provide at least one International Observer for both days of the competition. Every International Observer must have an International Observers License issued by the E.B.U.

1.3 The organizer of the European BikeTrial Championship will arrange a meeting for all Observers before the start of both the Saturday and Sunday competitions. This meeting will be to give the 'Observers' Promise' and the necessary instructions to each of the Observers.

1.4 The organizer will supply clear identification (e.g. a color coded T-shirt or arm band) to each of the observers so that the riders and spectators can easily identify them. The International Observer will be in overall control of their section will also wear their International Observers License. The organizer will supply the time keeper and punch card scorer.

1.5 The event organizer will supply all of the clocks, punches and yellow and red warning cards to be used by the Observers on each section.

1.6 The organizer will be allowed to choose what conditions and benefits he wishes to give to the Observers .

Art.02 QUALIFIED OBSERVERS AND LICENCES

2.1 It is recommended that an Observer should have at least two (2) years experience of observing at national level in their own countries and should be familiar with the BikeTrial International Union (B.I.U) rules as explained in the International Technical Rules (I.T.R). The national delegate of each country will confirm that their International Observers meet the required standards and will sign their application forms accordingly.

2.2 A qualified observer must be over 18 years of age.

2.3 Each qualified observer must be able to give instructions in English whilst they are observing in the competition (e.g. giving the time, penalty points, orders and instructions to the rider).

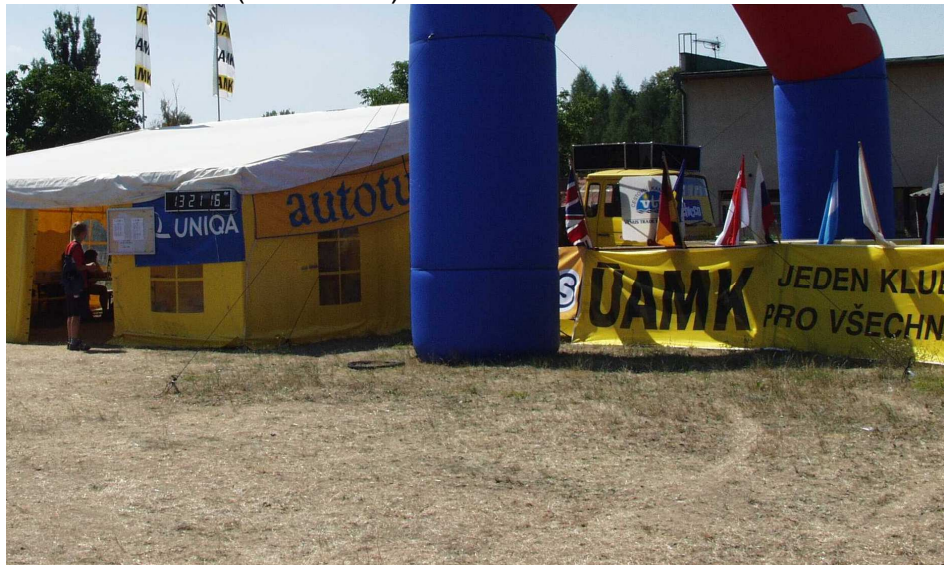

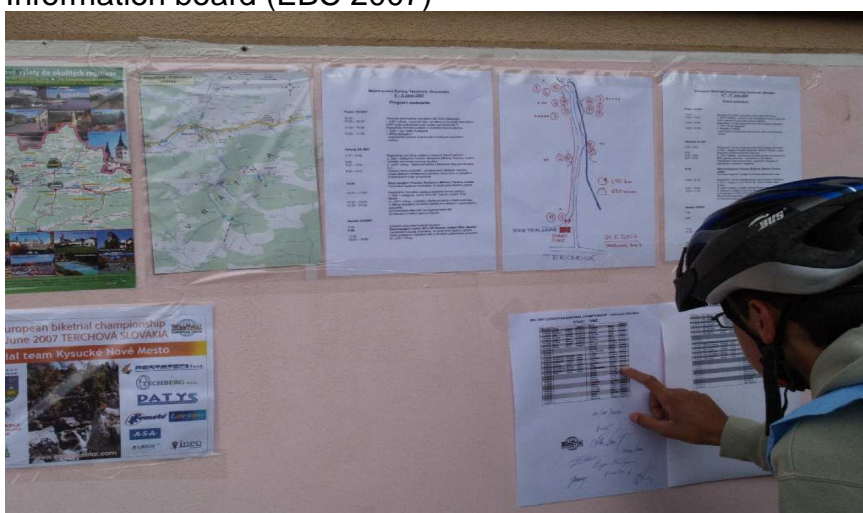
